A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF TYLER, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS FOR THE URGENT NEED PROJECT FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the COMMISSIONER'S COURT of the COUNTY of TYLER desires to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist which represent a threat to the public health and safety to low/moderate income persons, and benefit low/moderate income persons, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the COUNTY of TYLER to apply for funding under the 1986 Texas Community Development Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONER'S COURT OF THE COUNTY OF TYLER, TEXAS:

1. That a Texas Community Development Program application for community development project funding is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the COUNTY with the Texas Department of Community Affairs.
2. That the COUNTY'S application be placed in consideration for funding under the Urgent Need Fund.
3. That the application be for \_\_\_\_\_ of grant funds to carry out Bridge Replacement \_\_\_\_\_.
4. That the COMMISSIONER'S COURT directs and designates the County Judge as the COUNTY'S chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the COUNTY'S participation in the Texas Community Development Program.


