A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court was held on Friday, May 1, 1987 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was opened with prayer by Mr. Gordon Anderson.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan to appoint Josiah Wheat as County Judge, replacing Allen Sturrock. Commissioner Barnes seconded this motion. Commissioner Graham stated that he would be voting no because he felt there would be a conflict of interest and that Mr. Wheat would not be able to serve as a full-time Judge. Commissioner Conner, Commissioner Barnes and Commissioner Jordan all voted yes. Commissioner Graham voted no.

Commissioner Jordan stated that the appointment would become effective May 8, 1987 at the end of the work day.

Concern was expressed by the Criminal District Attorney, Pat Hardy and other citizens regarding the conflicts of interest with Mr. Wheat being also the attorney for the City of Woodville.
