A Special Meeting of the Commissioner's Court was held on Tuesday, September 8, 1987 at 10:00 A.M. All members being present. The meeting was called to order by Judge Wheat and opened with prayer by Rev. Raymond Parker, pastor of First Baptist Church of Woodville.

County Auditor, Janie DuBose submitted an alternate proposed budget to the court. She stated that since the court had voted to increase the revenues of citations in the Justice Court and tax certificates in the Tax Department along with increasing the tax rate by 1.03% and distributing it as follows: General Fund-26¢; Road &Bridge-12¢; Jail- 05¢ the alternate budget would be balanced.

Pat Brown, District Clerk reiterated the alternative that the County Auditor had proposed. Adding that each of the officials put a six months freeze on hiring and decrease in spending for the first three months.
