The Court met with Dennis Ultican, architect and a representative of Big Thicket Communications, Ed Phillips, to discuss problems with the installation of a **radio communications system in the Justice Center.**

It was the consensus of the court that Motorola bid a turn-key job and that they should provide necessary conduit, etc. for the system.

Judge Wheat stated to the court that to force Motorola to go through with their bid as understood by the Court and the architect would result in loss of time in getting the jail certified. It was his recommendation that the court consider another company that had bid. The loss of time mentioned would be caused by the dispute as to what Motorola's bid actually covered. **SEE ATTACHED CORRESPONDANCE.**

A motion was made by **Commissioner Barnes** and seconded by **Commissioner Graham** to stand at recess until 11:15 A.M. All voted yes.

After discussion, a motion was made by **Commissioner Conner** to reject the contract offered by **Motorola** as not being responsive to the bid requested, in accordance with the invitation to bid advertised as required by law, and that the County accept the bid of G.E./Trinity Communications for a "turn-key job". The court met with a representative of **Trinity Communications, Inc.**, Beaumont, Texas. No other motions were made.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Conner** and seconded by **Commissioner Graham** that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes.
