Wade Skinner and Gary Hennigan met with the Court to discuss the
possibilities of housing **INS prisoners** in the **Justice Center**.
Mr. Skinner stated that expenses of clothing, medical care, etc.
would not be a burden of the County, for these prisoners.

Judge Wheat paused to recognize superintendents of school districts in
Tyler County. They had met as the **Advisory Members of the Probation Board**
and notified the Court that they would be requesting funds in the
future for detention and emergency facilities for juveniles.

In the discussion concerning housing of INS prisoners, Commissioner Graham
stated that if the County entered into a contract it should state that
damages caused by these prisoners would be the responsibility of the
federal government to pay for the repairs.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Graham** and seconded by
Commissioner Conner to investigate which agencies have prisoners
the County would be willing to house in the **Justice Center** at a cost
of \$ 50.00 per day. The Sheriff's department will make a recommendation
at a future meeting. This will be an investigation only at no
obligation to the County. All voted yes and none no.

Judge Wheat recognized **District Judge Earl Stover**. Judge Stover stated
he would like to express his appreciation to the Court for the
cooperation that the Court had given and the support the Court had
given the District Court. He also reported that he and Judge Lawliss
had **appointed Janie DuBose as County Auditor** for another two year term
and expressed thanks for the cooperation the Court had given her.

Wade Skinner also reported that the jail was certified as of yesterday
and if they obtained more than the 10.8 daily average of prisoners
it was a possibility that additional jailers would have to be hired.

Judge Stover swore **Janie DuBose** in as **County Auditor** for another term.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by
Commissioner Graham that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.

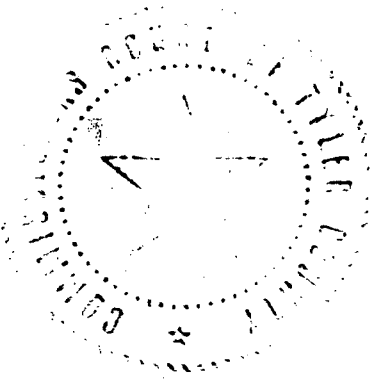
