Consulting Engineers was present at the hearing. There were no other persons present to speak toward this project. A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve the monthly report from the County Treasurer. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT.

Commissioner Jordan moved that the County Extension monthly report be accepted as presented to the Court. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Conner. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Conner to accept the monthly report from the Probation Department. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT.

The monthly report from the J.P. #1 was not available, therefore this item was deferred.

Commissioner Conner made a motion to approve the monthly report of the County Auditor. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Graham. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED STATEMENT OF CONDITION.

Commissioner Barnes moved that the allowances and accounts payable be approved as submitted by the County Auditor. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Conner. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED GENERAL LEDGER DISTRIBUTION REGISTER.

Consideration of contract with Ballard Exploration Pipe Line on a County Road was deferred until Friday, October 14, 1988.

The opening of bids on radios for the Tyler County Justice Center was deferred until Friday, October 14, 1988.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to allow up to 6 clerks for the General Election. All voted yes and none no.

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Consideration for acceptance of donation of land from Champion International at the garbage dump in Precinct #2 was deferred until Friday, October 14, 1988.

Consideration of budget amendments to FY 88 Budget was deferred until Friday, October 14, 1988.

No action was taken concerning the authorization of filing of an application for a boat ramp with Texas Parks and Wildlife, since the consensus was this had previously been approved.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to defer the request for payment by Everett Griffith, Jr. and Associates and AID until 1:00 P.M., giving them time to appear before the Court. All voted yes and none no.

COURT RECESSED UNTIL 1:00 P.M.

COURT BACK IN SESSION:

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to defer the public hearing on the budget until such time as the Court receives amount of revenues from the Tax Appraisal Distict. All voted yes and none no.

Mr. James W. Griffith and Dennis Ultican appeared before the Court requesting payment for services they performed on the Tyler County Justice Center. If the Court would not approve final payment, he wanted to know why. - Pat Hardy responded that the Court should not be charged for their appearances before the grand jury. Jordan stated that there was missing equipment from the Justice Center such as a camera, etc. and there were wires run and piled up- not connecting to anything. Mr. Griffith responded that there was a duplication of wiring and the electrician should take his problems to Nield Construction because his contract was not with the Court. Commissioner Graham reminded Mr. Griffith of the change-order process and that it was not followed. Mr. Griffith acknowledged that the electrician should have seen that the process had been followed in order to receive his fees. Commissioner Conner stated that the duplication of wiring was the fault of the AID. Mr. Griffith stated that if the Court would cut them a check today, he would be willing to drop the fees charged for appearing before the grand jury and interest charged. He also stated that other items in question would have to come under warranty for repairs. After much discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Jordan to approve payment to Everett Griffith & Associates in the amount of All voted yes and none no. \$2,299.15. SEE ATTACHED AFFIDAVIT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to adjourn the meeting. All voted yes.
