The representative from Texas Department of Health was not able to be present to discuss Tyler County solid waste disposal sites, therefore this matter was deferred until Monday, November 14, 1988 at 1:00P.M.

The County Auditor reported that Commissioner Graham had made cuts in his budget by cutting an employee (\$21,723.00) and road materials (\$5000.00) and bridge repairs (\$8000.00). Commissioner Barnes also made cuts in his budget toward balancing the proposed budget with a l¢ increase in Road and Bridge. A motion was made by Commissioner Graham that the proposed budget on file with the County Clerk be further amended to make changes reflected on the Auditors print-out with reference to Road and Bridge Precinct #2 and Precinct #3. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Conner to adopt the proposed budget on file with the County Clerk with the amendments made today and past Monday. The Auditor stated that she would present a new copy so that the amendments would be reflected and clear as a final budget. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Conner that the Courthouse maintenance and repairs be increased to \$45,000 and that the proposed budget as amended be adopted. He stated that the Courthouse was in dire need of repairs and wanted the surplus money to be used for same. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Jordan. All voted yes and none no, thereby adopting the proposed budget as amended.

A motion was made by Commissioner Graham and seconded by Commissioner Barnes that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.
