Ruth Stanford explained the nature of her accident and claim as to expenses incurred from same due to a fall at the Tyler County Justice Center. She stated that she did not file on her workmen's compensation insurance. Judge Wheat responded that workmen's compensation should pay her expenses although she had not lost time from work. Judge Wheat added that her claim should be presented to the contractor to see if his insurance carrier would pay the expenses. Pat Hardy advised that if a law suit will result, that this matter should be taken into an executive session; since the accident occurred on County property, the County would be joined in a suit. The County Judge instructed the County Clerk to post an agenda for an executive session to be held at 1:30 P.M.
