Commissioner Riley made a motion to defer consideration of a resolution on locating a 1000 man detention facility in Woodville until the County Judge could clear up some of the language in the resolution. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All uted yes and none no. Commissioner Jordan added that the Court would go on record supporting the detention facility being loc*ated in woodille.
