The Court convened for the purpose of a budget workshop for the 1990 Budget.

County Auditor, Joyce Moore presented a revised budget that deleted requests made by the County Departments supported by the General Fund. Along with the revised budget, Mrs. Moore also presented a budget request for the Tyler County Emergency Management.

Some of the principle concerns discussed were Court Appointed Attorneys; County Court allocations; Sanitary Landfill; Health Insurance premiums and Workmen's Compensation premiums.

Commissioner Jordan proposed that the Court allocate one-half of the revenues from fines to the General Fund and one-half to General Road and Bridge Fund. Commissioner Riley suggested that the Data Processing budget be reduced to \$70,000.00.

After much discussion and deliberations, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to adopt the 1990 Budget as presented in the workshop which calls for additions as follows:

Additionally, that the budget of the Tyler County Emergency Management be added to the budget and approved with the stipulation that

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the Sheriff's department will provide the telephone and radio requested; that the Date Processing Budget be reduced \$20,000 and that one-half of the revenues from fine collections be transferred to the General Fund to cover the additions made to the budget; that any remainder will be put into a contingency fund to be disbursed at the discretion of the Commissioner's Court. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED 1990 BUDGET.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jordan and seconded by Commissioner Riley that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes.
