The invocation was delivered by Judge Allen Sturrock.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to approve paying the bills as submitted by the County Auditor including an invoice from Foster & Sons Floor Covering for additional expense of base boards(\$60.00) in the Juvenile Probation Department with corrections that #77145 Triple S Crushed Stone(\$93.54) Precinct #3, should be divided between all four precincts. The bill from Triad#77074 will be held and not paid for further review. All voted yes and none no with Commissioner Barnes abstaining from voting on #77089 Barnes Plumbing (\$106.90). Commissioner Mahan introduced Archie Conner with Eastex Communications. Mr. Conner explained to the Court his present maintenance policy for radio equipment. After questioning Mr. Conner as to response time for service, a motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to designate Eastex Communications as the service facility to install and maintain the radio equipment purchased from Motorola for the road and bridge and County Judge. All voted yes and none no.

Kenny Simpson, Chief Probation Officer, requested the Court purchase a typewriter (\$676.00) and an I.B.M. computer terminal (\$748.00) for the Probation Department. Commissioner Riley made a motion to approve the purchase and that the Probation Department pay Tyler County \$200.00 per month for 6 months and \$224.00 on the seventh month for the use of the equipment. Commissioner Mahan seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED USE AGREEMENT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Mahan that the minutes of the January 8th meeting are approved, except that the words SEE APPROVAL BELOW be added to (report unavailable) in reference to the Extension Department monthly report. All voted yes and none no.

TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S COURT January 12, 1989

Mr. Emmons reported his findings of electrical problems within the Courthouse. A "ball-park-figure" of \$10,000 was expressed with the exclusion of the rewiring of individual offices. The proposal did include the replacement of breaker boxes as needed. After discussion concerning hazards of electrical problems, leaking roof and the tower, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley to table action for further review of the compounded problems to the building. Commissioner Barnes seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Barnes that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.
