Judge Owens described the hazardous condition of the radio tower on top of the courthouse. ~~Three~~^{Two} of the ~~four~~^{three} legs of the tripod are no longer connected. An oral bid of \$1800 had been given to Judge Owens from Tower Specialist, Inc.

Upon recommendation by Judge Owens, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley to enter into an agreement with Tower Specialists, Inc. That the agreement provide they take down the tower for \$1800 total price including hauling it to the dump site. Tyler County reserves the right to save as much of the tower and cable as the County desires. Also, that Tower Specialists, Inc. fully indemnify and hold harmless Tyler County from injury or cause of action for damages arising out of the performance of their work; that they assign any rights under any insurance policy under the certificate of insurance forwarded to the County to cover their performance; that they will perform this work as an independent contractor; and that they attain such other terms and conditions as may be provided in a contract written by the Criminal District Attorney or in his absence the County Judge; lastly, that the work be performed on a weekend. Commissioner Barnes seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE AND AGREEMENT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Barnes that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.
