Judge Owens reported that Commissioner Jordan had surgery and extended the Court's best wishes to him.

The purpose of this meeting was to act on additional salary adjustments from previous action of discontinuing the payment of premiums for dependent coverage of health insurance.

The County Auditor had further reviewed the budget for additional adjustments that would have no effect on the budget for next year causing a tax increase. Unfortunately, a ruling from the Attorney General states that the salary of elected officials could not be adjusted within a budget year.

Commissioner Barnes made a motion to accept the recommendation of the County Auditor making an adjustment to all county employees' salary of \$165.14, including the previous adjustment, and that this accommodation does not apply to elected officials. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Riley.

Commissioner Barnes further added to the previous motion that the County Auditor make such line-item transfers as necessary and that the County Auditor present these at the next meeting. This amendment was seconded by Commissioner Riley. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RECOMMENDATION.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan that the meeting adjourn. All voted yes and none no.
