James Clark informed the court that used books for the Law Library can be purchased as a base set for $\$ 7800$ which would be a savings of approximately $50 \%$. The carpet would be $\$ 456$ and a heat pump for \$800. A motion was made by Commissioner Riley to authorize a transfer of $\$ 10,000$ for the Law Library Fund for books and improvements. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no.

It is necessary that the County have an agreement on a month to month basis with Citizens State Bank (current depository) in the interim until such time the County can rebid for a bank depository.
