In discussion of restoration and repairs to the Courthouse, Commissioner Mahan proposed to spend up to \$3,000 for a grout floor, carpet, panelling, desk and two chairs. Judge Owens recommended a tile floor. A motion was then made by Commissioner Mahan to authorize an expenditure of \$3,500 for restoration and repairs to Room 102 of the Courthouse. This would not include revamping of the electrical system, however it does include a heat pump and glass door. Road and Bridge, Pct. #3 would be doing most of the labor which would cut the project cost in half. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley reported the addition of a part-time employee to do the grounds work for the Courthouse square. Elisha Dill would be janitor for the inside of the Courthouse only.

A motion was made to adjourn by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Riley. All voted yes.
