the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Special Meeting at the Commissioner's Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to approve the minutes of April 29, 1991. All voted yes and none no.

Wayne Stolz with Everett Griffith, Jr. & Assoc., Inc. recommended the construction award for the HUD Grant on the road east of Warren (Precinct #1) be given to the lowest bidder contingent upon verification of references. Mr. Stolz had only received the list of references prior to the meeting. Since the bid was more than allowed by the grant, David Waxman recommended two alternatives, one being to award the base bid with change orders up; the other, to award total supplementary bid with change orders deletions. After discussion, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley to award the the bid to J & D Construction based on the recommendation of the engineer with the stipulation that the engineer and grant administrator be satisfied as to the verified references. The award is for the base bid of \$206,000.00 to which change orders will be made by approval of the commissioners' court. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED BID TABULATION.

After being read in full by the County Judge, a resolution was adopted petitioning the Governor Richards to veto HB 1007, upon motion by Commissioner Mahan. Commissioner Riley seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no. HB 1007 limits the authority of the County to restrict use of local roads by overweighted vehicles. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION.

After review of the budget of the Tyler County Tax Appraisal District, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley to table consideration until June 10. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mahan. All voted yes and none no. There were increases in salary and the allocated assessment of Tyler County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to adjourn. All voted yes.
