a Regular Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville,

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by
Commissioner Sawyer to defer the approval of minutes until
Thursday, July 11, 1991. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by
Commissioner Riley to table approval of the County Treasurer's
monthly report, County Auditor's monthly report and allowances and
accounts payable until Thursday, July 11, 1991. All voted yes and
none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by
Commissioner Sawyer that the monthly report of the Extension
Department be approved as submitted. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to accept the monthly reports
of the Probation Departments (Adult and Juvenile) as filed. This
motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and
none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORTS.

Commissioner Mahan made a motion to table the monthly report of
Wanda Brasher, J.P. #1 until Thursday, July 11, 1991, due to late
bank statements. Commissioner Sawyer seconded this motion. All
voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Mahan made a motion to approve up to \$325.00 for the
purchase of a glass door for the District Clerk's office.
Commissioner Barnes seconded this motion. All voted yes and none
no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by
Commissioner Mahan to approve the request of the District
Attorney to purchase two secretarial chairs. All voted yes and
none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by
Commissioner Mahan to authorize Commissioner Riley to purchase a
riding mower for up to \$2500.00 and push mower for up to \$500.00 for
the courthouse and the justice center. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley introduced Christopher Castilaw and his wife to
members of the Court. Chris had served in Desert Storm conflict
in Saudi Arabia. Christ thanked the court for their support,
expressing the boost to the moral of the service men and women.

Judge Owens told the Court that today was set aside to acknowledge some people of the County that had contributed in special and personal ways to benefit the County in unselfish ways. Judge Owens then expressed to Bro. C.A. Bevil publicly and in behalf of Commissioners' Court all that he has done for the County when he asks for no credit but "just to serve". Commissioner Riley then presented a plaque to Bro. Bevil which expressed gratitude for his volunteer services. Judge Owens then commended the Sheriff's Posse for their unselfish refurbishing the Rodeo Arena and for their assistance to the Sheriff's Office in projects and for the tremendous service which they provided to the County. Terry Riley then introduced Linda Wells telling the Court that everyone else was working and could not attend. *

COURT BACK IN SESSION.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to appoint election judges as recommended and amended by Commissioner Mahan which would authorize precinct boxes 5,8,9,11 & 17 to have an Election Judge, an Alternate judge and two clerks with the remaining larger boxes to have authorization to hire additional clerks as needed up to a maximum of 4 additional clerks. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley made the motion to adopt resolutions of agreements between Tyler County and the Warren and Spurger School Districts for the purpose of joint elections. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to approve the Prisoner Custody Agreement which was recommended by Sheriff Hennigan and approved by the District Attorney's Office. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED AGREEMENT.

Sheriff Hennigan introduced Ron Foster, a commander with the Southeast Texas Narcotics and Intelligence Task Force. Mr. Foster told the Court that the Task Force was a big success in the past year making over 572 cases with the budget being \$425,000 and with a savings of approximately \$20,000 to \$25,000. There was approximately \$35,000 spent in Tyler County in the last year which represented 18 cases made in Tyler County. A motion was made by Commissioner Sawyer to approve the Cooperative Agreement for the formation of and participation in the local Southeast Texas Narcotics and Intelligence Task Force. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mahan. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED AGREEMENT.

Commissioner Mahan made the motion to adjourn. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes.
