COUNTY OF TYLER ON THIS THE 12th DAY OF AUGUST, 1991 the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Regular Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to approve the minutes of June 10 and June 14, 1991. All voted yes and none no.

An extension monthly report was not submitted due to vacancy of agents.

Commissioner Mahan motioned to approve the County Treasurer's monthly report as submitted by Jean Phillips. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT. Judge Owens commented on attachment from TAC that the major medical insurance premium will increase by 8% for the coming year. However, it remains a significant drop in payment of last few years.

Commissioner Riley made a motion to accept the monthly reports of the Probation Departments (Adult and Juvenile) as filed. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORTS.

Commissioner Sawyer made a motion to accept the monthly report of Wanda Brasher, J.P. #1 as filed. Commissioner Mahan seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT.

After review of the monthly report submitted by the County Auditor, a motion was made by Commissioner Riley to approve same as printed. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED STATEMENT OF CONDITION.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to approve allowances and accounts payable from the County Auditor's Office. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED GENERAL LEDGER DISTRIBUTION REGISTER AND ACCOUNTS PAYABLE PAID.

Upon recommendation of Sheriff Hennigan, Commissioner Riley made the motion to approve the purchase of a Monroe copy machine with a 3 year maintenance agreement in the amount of \$6,654.95 for the Sheriff's Department. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no.

TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT August 12, 1991

Sheriff Hennigan reported to the Court that the jail certification had gone smoothly. A strict examination brought a very good report. SEE REPORT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to re-appoint Commissioner Riley to the DETCOG Board of Directors. All voted yes and none no. Commissioner Riley expressed his appreciation of the Court's support and reported that he had been appointed as secretary of the DETCOG Board.

Upon recommendation of Elaine Clow, Commissioner Riley made the motion to appoint Robin Baschnager and Patricia Sturlese to the Child Welfare Board for a 3 year period. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no. Commissioner Riley then made a motion to approve \$187.68 for foster child care expenses. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. voted yes and none no. Mrs. Clow made the Court aware of anticipated needs of children in foster care. Judge Owens urged her to seek assistance of clothing from local churches. Commissioner Mahan made the motion to transfer \$300.00 from medical expenses to clothing for the children. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Riley. All voted yes and none no. She also reported that the County could request jurors to donate their compensation to the ·Child Welfare Board. Judge Owens advised this be presented to the district judges. Additionally, Mrs. Clow explained the expenses that could be incurred toward "emergency foster care." A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to make \$500 available until January 1,1992 to Attention Homes as part of the Child Welfare Board budget. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED. Additional funding will be reviewed during budget workshops.

Members of the White Tail Ridge Volunteer Fire Department requested to Court to consider a petition calling an election creating a rural fire prevention district #3. However, only 91 of the petitioners qualified. A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to table discussion of the petition for the creation of the Fire District III until the required 100 qualified petitioners could be secured.

Commissioner Mahan made the motion to table the approval of the Lease Agreement between Kirby Forest Industries, Inc. and Tyler County Precincts II, III and IV until Friday, concerning a rock pit. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Barnes. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to advertise for bids on Bank Depository which will be opened on September 10, 1991; that the application shall contain general terms as used in the past; and, that the terms be further reviewed by the County Treasurer, County Auditor, County Judge, and County Clerk and placed in proper provisions. The application shall contain provisions that the County reserves the right to deposit discretionary funds in TEXPOOL; and, that the County's existing obligations will be refinanced under the new agreement at a rate consistent with the bid received by the depository. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED INVITATION.

Commissioner Mahan made the motion to adopt by resolution the appointment of Barbara Tolbert to the Tyler County Appraisal District's Board of Directors. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes and none no. RESOLUTION ATTACHED.

Judge Owen's presented Jean Phillips, County Treasurer, with the Certification Award from V.G. Young Institute of County Government.
