A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to approve paying bills submitted by the County Auditor's office with the modification of invoice #0135 in the amount of \$92.76 to Kirby Memorial and invoice #00228 to Office Supply in the amount of \$14.50. All voted yes with the exception of Commissioner Barnes abstaining. SEE ATTACHED LEDGER DISTRIBUTION.

Commissioner Barnes made the motion to approve the continuation of an agreement to maintain streets between the City of Chester and Precinct #2 of Tyler County. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED AGREEMENT. James Clark advised that it was in compliance with pertaining laws.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes to approve line-item transfers from the Sheriff's Department, Foster Child Care, an additional Janitor and others within their departments as submitted from the County Auditor's Office with the exception of the telephone bill from the Sheriff's Office to be amended to show an increase to \$3,000. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mahan. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED LINE-ITEM TRANSFERS.

Commissioner Mahan made the motion to authorize Joyce Moore to purchase a new typewriter in the amount of \$899.00 from Story-Wright (\$500 from Data Processing and \$399 from the County Auditor's budget) for the County Auditor's Office. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes and seconded by Commissioner Mahan to advertise for bids to purchase two new patrol cars for the Sheriff's Department from the 1991 budget. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Mahan. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED NOTICE TO BIDDERS.

Commissioner Sawyer made the motion to advertise for bids to sell two used cars, 1986 Ford and 1984 Crown Victoria, from the Sheriff's Department. Commissioner Mahan seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED NOTICE TO BIDDERS.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan to table the approval of the lease agreement concerning the rock pit, between Kirby Forest Industries, Inc. and Tyler County Precincts II, III and IV. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted yes and none no.
