Representatives of the Texas Department of Transportation updated the
 Court on the Rawls Creek Bridge in Precinct #3. Jimmy Crews reported
 that this was basically an agreement for the County to tie into the
 state's proposed roadway upon completion, which had been agreed upon
 years earlier. The commission in Austin requires that this agreement
 be in writing. The County had previously made a payment toward this
 project on May 26, 1988 in the amount of \$16,600. The remainder of
 additional funding, approximately \$7000 will come from Road & Bridge
 #3.

After reading of the whole by Judge Owens, Commissioner Mahan
 motioned that the resolution concerning Rawls Creek Bridge be
 adopted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Riley.
 All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION.

The representatives complimented the County Clerk on her cooperation
 for the use and copies of the records on the Highway 92 North
 project, which saved the highway department and taxpayers a
 tremendous amount of time and money, which will save the County in
 the long run.

Commissioner Riley motioned that the meeting adjourn.
