The Court convened in a public hearing to present the proposed budget for 1993 and to hear comments from tax payers.

Each Commissioner asserted their views of the proposed budget taking pride that the budget does not call for a tax increase. Commissioners observation of no tax increase was in large due to management; services have been increased without an increase in tax rates and commending the work done by elected officials in past years to cut-back where the County would have the money without tax increases.

Judge Owens answered questions from the press concerning the increase in workman's compensation insurance premiums.

Commissioner Mahan made a adjustment in Road & Bridge #3 changing the line item labeled "part-time salaries" to "part-time and over-time salaries".

The total budget is \$4,565,499.50. Ad valorem taxes brings the General Fund \$1,311,654.00 and Road & Bridge \$2,010,780.00. Commissioner Riley commented that less than half of the budget comes from taxes, the rest is derived from management, fees & fines and grants.
