a Special Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville,

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by
Commissioner Mahan to table award of computer proposals until a
study can be made of the size needed to add the departments of the
Tax Office and County Auditor, integrating the County departments
onto one system. Also, whether this system could communicate and
use information from the Tax Appraisal District's computer, if
used by the Tax Office. All voted yes and none no. The County Judge
appointed Sandra Harrison, Assessor\Collector and Linda Lewis, Chief
Appraiser to the committee studying the proposals submitted for a
computer system.

The County Judge asked the County Clerk to address the need of
additional space for her department. Additionally, he asked the
County Auditor and Criminal District Attorney to explain the
procedures for bidding through the Resolution Trust Company.
Commissioner Mahan motioned to adopt a resolution authorizing the
County Judge to represent Tyler County in making a bid on the
Jasper Federal Savings & Loan building for up to \$165,000; and,
that the Criminal District Attorney draft a power of attorney, in
line with this resolution. Commissioner Sawyer seconded this
motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION AND
POWER OF ATTORNEY.

The County Clerk and Lt. Tracy Ferguson from the Sheriff's
department enlightened the Court of information toward the study of
expansion of the computer system such as bidding procedures and

grant funds received for this project.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner
