the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in
a Special Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville,
Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

the following were absent: none thereby constituting a quorum.
In addition to the above were:

JOYCE MOORE COUNTY AUDITOR

A motion was made by Commissioner Sawyer and seconded by
Commissioner Riley to approve the minutes of March 12, 1993.
All voted yes and none no.

Item #2 - approval of allowances and accounts payable should have
been deleted according to the County Auditor.

Commissioner Barnes motioned to approve the purchase of a used
Mack Truck in the amount of \$32,000 from Richmond Garage, Trucks
and Equipment, Burkeville, Texas, according to specifications they
submitted, paying \$10,000 down and the remainder of \$22,000 in two
time warrants. The bed and trailer hook up will be paid from Road &
Bridge #2.(\$6600) The motion was seconded by Commissioner
Riley. Commissioner Mahan suggested that future specifications for
used vehicles and equipment include a clause stating "subject to
availability".

Diane Duhon gave a presentation proposing to expand and change the
name of the agency, Women and Children's Shelter to Tyler County
Victims Assistance Center. They are contemplating to employ two
full time employees, a victims advocate and a volunteer
coordinator. After reading of the whole, a motion was made by
Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to adopt
the resolution concerning a Victim Of Crime Act Grant,
authorizing the County Judge to execute all documents concerning
this grant. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan that the unexpected
additional amount of \$11,725.34 be paid, as requested by the
Texas Department of Transportation as a part of the state
off-system bridge program, from ROW funds instead of Road &
Bridge #3, provided that an examination has been made by
Commissioner of Precinct #3 - that the cost is reasonable to be paid
by the County; and, that the County Judge has approved payment of
those funds for the completion of the bridge(Rawls Creek) in
Precinct #3. Commissioner Riley seconded this motion. All voted
yes and none no. In general discussion, future allocations might
use the same percentage being paid by the precincts and the ROW
fund, being equal and fair to other precincts.

The District Clerk not being available, Commissioner Mahan
motioned to table consideration and approval for the purchase of a
revolving file cabinet for the District Clerk's office.
Commissioner Riley seconded this motion. All voted yes and no.

Commissioner Riley moved that the meeting adjourn.
