A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Riley to authorize the change of polling place for Box #10. Voting will take place in the City Hall for the June 5th election. The City Hall shares the same parking place as that of the Community Center (regular polling place). The Community Center had been previously scheduled for an event that could not be changed. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Mahan and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to authorize the change of polling place for Box #17. Voting will take place in a recreational vehicle to be parked next to the Lions Den. An event was previously scheduled at the Lions Den that could not be changed. All voted yes and none no.

The Court reviewed the agreement with Mr. Wayne Stolz concerning the base price of the project and a cost not to exceed \$1500 for inspections (charged per hour). Reimbursable expenses are defined as any change in the scope of the project. Mr. Stolz made the Court aware of "draft rules" adopted by the Water Commission between transfer stations and collection centers. A motion was made by Commissioner Sawyer to approve a letter of agreement with Everett Griffith, Jr. & Associates, Inc. for the creation of a community collection center. Commissioner Riley seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.
