Judge Owens delved into the requirements of a performance bond. A payment and performance bond of 100% will be provided upon the execution of a contract.

Commissioner Mahan inquired as to a chain link fence around the site. Since Mr. Fortenberry did not itemized his bid, Mr. Stolz was unaware at this time as to the cost of enclosing the entire area. It was the consensus of the Court the if money is available that the entire tract be enclosed. If money is available, a change order would be brought before the court. The County will have this option throught the contract.

Commissioner Sawyer motioned to enter into a contract with Thomas C. Fortenberry for bid amount of \$267,300; additionally to have the option to take the added alternate of \$15,700 when additional funds are available at the County's election. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Riley. Judge Owens noted he would be abstaining from the vote of the question due to his representing Mr. Fortenberry in another matter.
