**Commissioner Mahan** discussed three main areas of the **Texaco pipeline permit** which concerns crossing a road in **Precinct #3**. Jimmy Renoudet was present representing Texasco. Texasco is to construct and maintain this pipeline at no expense to the County; Tyler County will not be held liable for any hazardous conditions and/or accidents during the installation and maintenance of this pipeline; and Texasco will meet all Texas Department of Transportation specifications so that Tyler County will incur no additional expenses at the time of construction of Hwy. 92 extension. **Commissioner Riley** made a motion to approve the permit for the pipeline which was seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED LETTER AGREEMENT.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Riley** to advertise for bids on **communication equipment** for the **Sheriff's Dept.** and **repeaters** for the commissioners. The bids are to be opened at the Regular meeting on February 14 at 10:00 a.m. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED NOTICE.

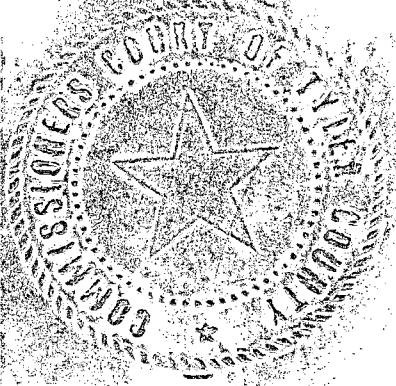

LETTER AGREEMENT

Pipeline Crossings for Tyler County Road to Serve Texaco  
Exploration and Production Inc. Production Well Long Bell A-1048  
A/C O/U 1 #1H

Dear Mr. Mahan:

Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. is requesting permission to cross your Tyler County Road, adjacent to the newly constructed access road to our proposed Hopson Mills Creek Gas Treatment Facility, with three (3) - 6 inch high pressure gas pipelines. Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. will activate only one of the three crossings at this time to serve the production well "Long Bell A-1048 A/C O/U 1 #1H" in the Brookeland Field, Hopson Mills Creek Area, Tyler County, Texas. Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. shall furnish all equipment, materials, labor, supervision, services, transportation, engineering and insurance necessary to install the pipelines and shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. All pipeline construction shall meet the terms and conditions of ANSI/ASME B31.8 "Gas Transmission and Distribution Piping, applicable codes of the American Petroleum Institute and Texaco Exploration and Production Inc. specifications and drawings for the fiberglass pipeline road crossings.
2. The work shall be performed in accordance with Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc.'s Permit Application dated January 11, 1994, documents on file and which are made a part hereof.
3. Subsequent removal of the pipelines shall be the responsibility of Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc. Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc. shall bear all expenses for removal and return of the right-of-way crossing to the original condition.
4. Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc. shall be responsible for any damage and associated repair cost to the County Right-of-Way as a result of the installation and/or operation of the pipelines.

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
5. Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc. will cooperate with the Texas Department of Transportation in the pipeline crossings of the proposed Highway 92 extension Right-of-Way and will install the pipeline crossings according to the Texas Department of Transportation specifications so that Tyler County will incur no additional work or expenses at the time of construction of the Highway 92 extension.

Additions and deletions to the pipeline construction shall be made in accordance with the documents referenced above and will require prior approval by the Tyler County Commissioner.

It is to be explicitly understood that there shall be no contract between the Tyler County Government agencies, and Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc. until such time as this Letter Agreement has been executed, and all the terms, conditions and requirements of the Contract have been met by Texaco Exploration and Production, Inc.

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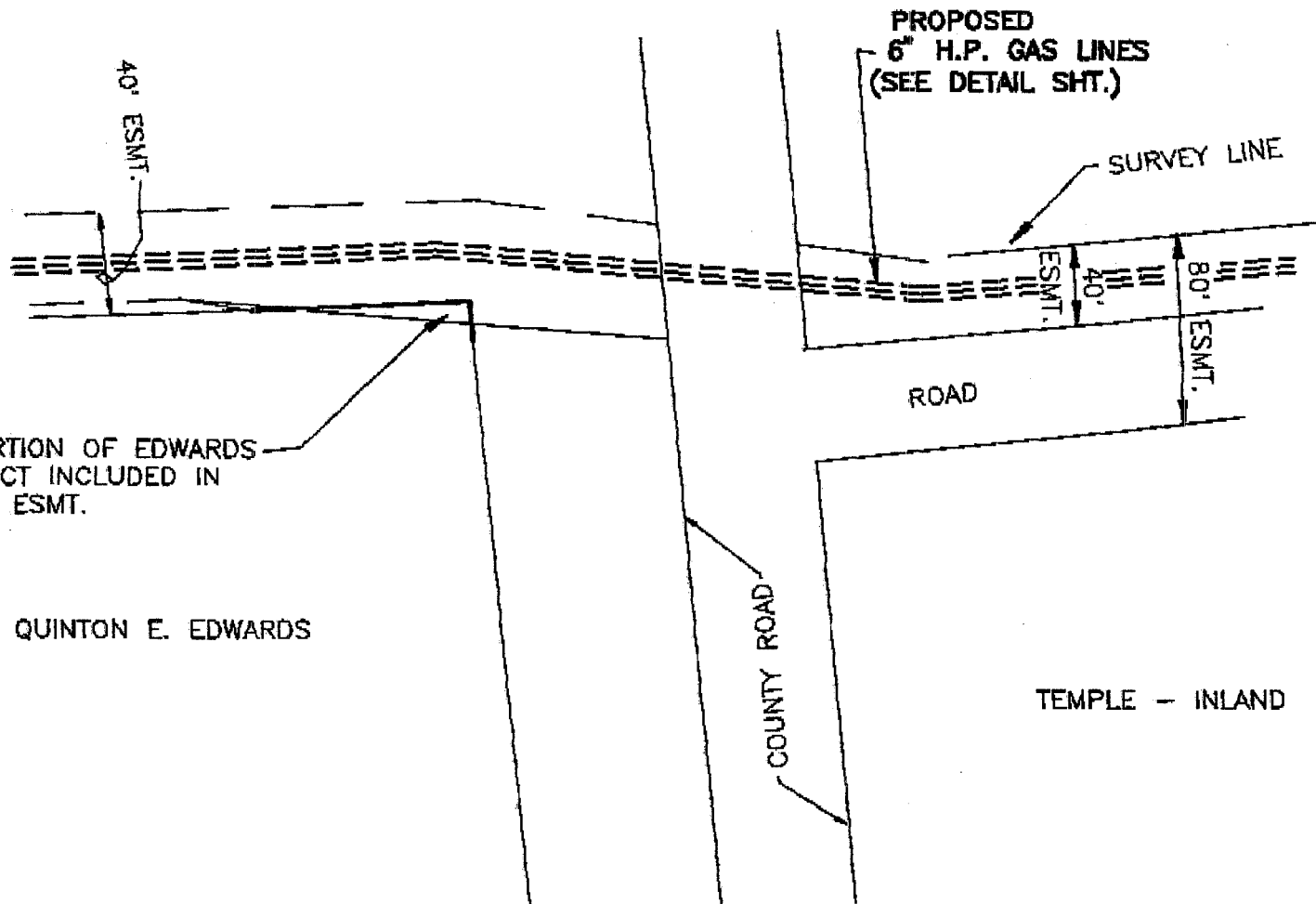
