Commissioners met with representatives from DETCOG, Postal Service, Southwestern Bell, etc. to discuss enhancing the present 911 emergency system.

Discussion was had toward road inventory; and, the process of establishing addressing using the "100 rule".; and, installing signage. It was also noted that "routing" with the postal service was becoming obsolete.

Melinda Grimes with DETCOG, reported \$26,423.00 of funding was available for Tyler County.

Commissioner Mahan proposed putting the data base for the updating the system at the Appraisal District. A representative from Southwestern Bell indicated the system would eventually be housed by the telephone company.

The District Postal Manager indicated the postal service prefers names for roads instead of numbers. He asked that this be given considerable review.
