A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner  
Mahan to adopt the fees to be charged by the Sheriff and Constables,  
effective January 1995. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Tina Bump summarized the options presented by FORTIS and Blue  
Cross\Blue Shield. She had not received acceptance from Travellers.  
She had investigated the ratings through the Texas Insurance Board.  
It was Mrs. Bump's recommendation the Court accept the proposal for  
health insurance from FORTIS.







Commissioner Mahan condensed the desire to obtain a \$250 deductible  
plan without dental coverage and with \$25,000 life insurance policy.  
Commissioner Mahan asked how a pre-existing condition was  
identifiable. The representative explained the company investigates  
through the doctor's records. If one is not covered by the present  
insurance carrier, there would be a twelve month waiting period for  
pre-existing conditions to be covered. The premium for a spouse and  
a child will be \$308; a child only is \$149.00.

Judge Owens indicated that he had rather give the difference to  
employees in their pay check than with added benefits to insurance  
coverage which results in additional premium cost.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley to accept the \$250 deductible  
plan from FORTIS without the dental coverage, to be effective October  
1, 1994. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Sawyer. All voted  
yes and none no.

Judge Owens encouraged the representative to get Tyler County  
Hospital in their network of their 90\10 plan.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, THE MEETING ADJOURNED.

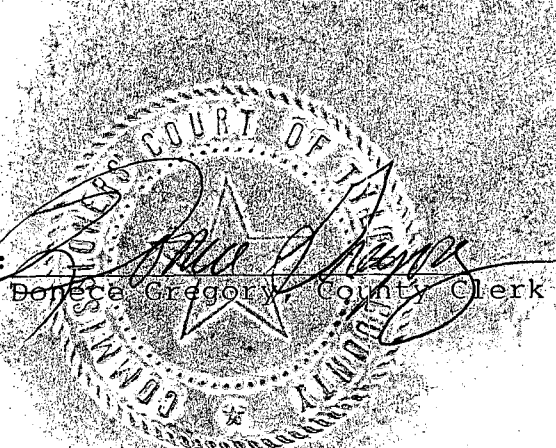
FEEES CHARGED BY THE SHERIFF AND CONSTABLES OF TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS
