A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve the minutes of May 16th, 1997. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the County Treasurer's monthly report. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to approve the monthly report of the Juvenile Probation Department. Adult Probation department will be tabled to Friday for review. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to table accepting the monthly report of Justice of Peace, Pct. #1 until Friday. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Riley motioned to approve the monthly report of the Extension Department. Commissioner Sawyer seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Barnes motioned to approve the County Auditor's monthly report. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED STATEMENT OF CONDITION.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve the allowances and accounts payable. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED DISTRIBUTION LEDGER.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to accept a road off Westbrook Road, being 7/10ths of a mile to be designated as county road #2931. All voted yes and none no.

Sheriff Hennigan requested a \$25 call out charge in stockman fees if an animal is impounded. The stockman now receives \$250.00 per month plus \$100 a month for gasoline. Gary requested an additional \$100 per month raise. Commissioner Marshall was concerned that estrays have not been recorded in the county records. After much discussion, Commissioner Riley motioned that stockman fees generated be deposited into General Fund; that the stockman receive no more than \$100 in generated fees from the general fund -effective July 1, 1997; and that he submit a monthly report; and that estrays be recorded in the office of the County Clerk. Commissioner Marshall seconded this motion. All voted yes and none no.

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A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Barnes that a formal request for unclaimed funds be made to the Comptroller of Public Accounts. All voted yes and none no. These funds are from monies received from refunds by utility companies who have a bad address of their customer, etc. (No funds were available at this time) The County Treasurer will make an official written request.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes to appoint Debbie Land, replacing David Tate to the board of commissioners of the Rural Fire Prevention District #3, WTR. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to approve the official bond of Carlos Abello as Assistant Criminal District Attorney in the Criminal District Attorney's department. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED OFFICIAL BOND.




Commissioner Riley motioned this meeting adjourned.




Maxie L. Riley, Comm. Pct. #1




A. M. Barnes, Comm. Pct. #2
