A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to approve minutes of October 13, 1997. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the County Treasurer's monthly report, as balanced with the County Auditor. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve the monthly report of the Juvenile Probation and Adult Probation departments. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Committing on a "good report", a motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to accept the monthly report of Justice of Peace, Pct. #1. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Riley motioned to approve the monthly report of the Extension Department. Commissioner Sawyer seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

The County Treasurer presented a buy-back study of the Retirement System. A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to table this matter until the meeting in December, 1997 for further study of what it might cost the County long-term. All voted yes and none no.
