Judge Owens opened the meeting for the purpose of a public hearing to consider the petition calling an election to create a Rural Fire District within the boundaries as presented on the petition in the Fred area.

Judge Owens asked for comments from the elected officials present. All were in favor and support of the creation of this fire prevention district. He informed those present of the process of calling an election and that it would be done in an expedient manner in order to have the election in March of 1998. However, if pre-clearance was not obtain from the Justice Department in time, the election would have to be delayed.

All those present were in favor of the creation of the fire district. There were no negative comments. Mr. Gibson indicated that he voted in Fred, however his home was included in the Warren Fire District. He was in favor of the Fred District annexing the area from the Warren District.

Judge Owens set this matter for the December 8, 1997 agenda of the Commissioners Court. The fee for the election will be due at that time.
