the Commissioners' Court in and for Tyler County, Texas convened in a Special Meeting at the Commissioners' Courtroom in Woodville, Texas, the following members of the Court present, to wit:

the following were absent: Judge Owens thereby constituting a quorum. In addition to the above were:

Kimberly Broom, representing Woodville FFA, presented a plaque to the Court for service to the County Fair.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve minutes of December 12, 1997. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sawyer and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve paying the bills, as submitted by the County Auditor. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Barnes motioned to approve a purchase/transfer of a side boom bushhog from Precinct #3 to Precinct #1. Commissioner Sawyer seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sawyer and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to accept the monthly report of Justice of Peace, Pct. #1. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Barnes to award the bid of two new cars for the Sheriff's department to Knapp Ford in the amount of \$39,195.00, as recommended by Sheriff Hennigan. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED BID.

Judge Riley announced that he had conversed with the County Auditor and Sheriff Hennigan concerning security for Ivanhoe Subdivision. He felt there would be no opposition from the Court as long as the pay is provided for by Ivanhoe. They preferred the gasoline be kept on a separate account; that, should the cost of this deputy ceased to be paid for by Ivanhoe - this slot would be deleted; their hire would be under the jurisdiction of the Sheriff. Judge Riley motioned to authorize a deputy for security for Ivanhoe upon the terms stated. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. Sheriff Hennigan felt it would be a great benefit to the county and a good relationship for Ivanhoe. He added he had talked with the candidate and explained the terms of salary and "all he has is four months". Compliments were exchanged between Ivanhoe property owners and Judge Riley.

Commissioner Sawyer motioned to approve a purchase/transfer of a motor grader from Precinct #3 to Precinct #4. Commissioner Barnes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. Commissioner Marshall explained the sale of this equipment was in the best interest of his precinct in order to purchase a more needed piece of machinery.

Judge Riley adjourned the meeting.
