The County Judge being in a Probate hearing, Commissioner Riley opened the meeting.

An invocation was delivered by C.D. Woodrome.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sawyer** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the minutes of April 17th, 1998. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Sawyer motioned to approve the monthly report of the County Treasurer. Commissioner Barnes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT.

Commissioner Sawyer motioned to approve the monthly reports of the Adult and Juvenile Probation Departments, as submitted. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Marshall. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORTS.

Commissioner Sawyer motioned to accept the monthly report of the Justice of the Peace, Pct. #1. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Marshall. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED REPORT.
