A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer** to approve the minutes of August 10, 1998. All voted yes and none no.

Judge Owens announced that he had appointed Lewis Craven to the Committee on Aging.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Riley** and seconded by **Commissioner Barnes** to approve paying the **bills**, as submitted by the **County Auditor**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Riley** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the line item transfers within the respective departments as presented by the **County Auditor**, **Joyce Moore**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

James Clark presented a request for a salary supplement for the assistant District Attorney, Joe R. Smith. He explained that due to case load and legislation preventing private practice, Mr. Smith would be limited to the cases he could take in his private practice due to his taking office January 1 (ending his private practice). Mr. Clark indicated that he would match the salary increase out of funds from the **Criminal District Attorney's office**. A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve \$750 per month to the end of 1998; and, that a **line-item transfer** be approved making a transfer of funds. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Riley**. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to appoint Lewis Craven as **alternate election judge** in Box#9 and Bobby Martin as alternate judge in Box#4; in seconding the motion, **Commissioner Riley** asked that a resolution be adopted praising Claudia Nash for her service to the County. The County Clerk requested that other judges be added to the resolution. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Riley** to approve a **community service contract with the adult probation department** as presented by Kenny Simpson, upon the approval of the County Judge. **Commissioner Barnes** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED. Mr. Simpson pointed out a change of fees from \$143.25 to \$170 per day based upon 312 work days.

Commissioner Sawyer motioned the meeting adjourned.
