A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Barnes to approve the minutes of September 17, 1998. All voted yes and none no.

Tina Bump reported the current interest rates on investments being 5.573% with C.D.s earning 4.8%. Commissioner Sawyer motioned to approve the monthly report, as reconciled with that of the County Auditor, of the County Treasurer. Commissioner Barnes seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.
