Melinda Grimes, Jimmy & Everett, representing DETCOG, gave an update on the 911 rural addressing program. Jesse Wolf expressed the good signage for peace officers and ambulances. They are working on the discrepancies found in the previous addressing between the post offices and the mapping project; next telephone records will have to be matched with the 911 records. They are presently working the Warren area; routes to Fred and Spurger will be next. Jimmy will be getting with each commissioner to map road that have been missed. Judge Owens presented the progress that had already been accomplished: the entire county had been mapped

road signs had been made and put into place maps show structures and residences

The system is in the refining process now. The enhanced system for the sheriff office will be put into place after the post office and telephone records are matched with present 911 records.
