A motion was made by Commissioner Riley and seconded by Commissioner Sawyer to  
approve the minutes of March 17, 2000. All voted yes and none no.

**Commissioner Sawyer** motioned to table approval of the **County Treasurer's monthly  
reports** for February and March until Friday. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the  
motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Sawyer** to approve the **County Probation

**Commissioner Hughes** made a motion to table approval of the **County Auditor's monthly report** until Friday, April 14th. **Commissioner Sawyer** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve the allowances and accounts payable as submitted by the County Auditor. **Commissioner Sawyer** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Judge Riley presented the Load Posting Agreement with the **Texas Department of Transportation** for bridges in the county. **Commissioner Marshall** motioned and seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer** to approve the agreement and authorize Judge Owens to execute it. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED AGREEMENT.

**Commissioner Marshall** motioned to authorize up to \$3000 for payment to Graham Luhn, architect for the courthouse preservation master plan and grant application. This will be paid out of the contingency fund. **Commissioner Sawyer** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer** to reappoint Ona Lee Seamans, Dr. Bob Swearingen and James Harold Brown to the **Tyler County Hospital Board**; and, appoint Tommy Hamilton to fill the unexpired term of Allen Bell. All voted yes and none no. Mrs. Seamans indicated the merger of the hospital to Memorial of Lufkin, in order to maintain the quality of the hospital and that it remain open for the citizens of the county.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** to approve the giving of an easement to Thomas Taylor for access to his property off CR2015, near the airport in Precinct #2. **Commissioner Sawyer** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED FIELD NOTES.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer** to approve the purchase, up to \$300, of 35mm cameras for three patrol cars of the **Department of Public Safety**, as requested by Officer Bill Lohmann. The DPS department will continue to furnish the film. The cameras will be used for crime scenes and fatalities. All voted yes and none no. This purchase will be paid from the contingency fund.

Ted Lukeman previously with PEBSCO indicated that PEBSCO no longer wanted to administer small accounts of deferred compensation 457 plans. He presented a proposal from COPELAND. Since this was not an agenda item. No action was discussed or taken.



BRIDGE LOAD POSTING AGREEMENT

STATE OF TEXAS )  
COUNTY OF TRAVIS )

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

THIS AGREEMENT, made entered into and executed this 17 day of April, 2000, by and between the State of Texas acting by and through the Engineer - Director, with approval of the Texas Department of Transportation District, hereinafter called the "State," and Tyler County hereinafter called the "Local Jurisdiction"

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the State desires to enter into an agreement with the Local Jurisdiction concerning the installation of load posting signs on bridges within the Local Jurisdiction;

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, the State and the Local Jurisdiction, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, do mutually agree as follows:

The Local Jurisdiction agrees to order load posting signs from the State, the State agrees to administer Federal funds to provide the load posting signs at no cost to the Local Jurisdiction, and the Local Jurisdiction agrees to take delivery, install, and maintain the signs as stated in the sections to follow.

1. Signs. The Local Jurisdiction hereby orders the following quantities of signs:

- Sign R12-2Tb 31 ea.
- Sign R12-2Tc 4 ea.
- Sign R12-4Tb - ea.
- Sign W12-5 20 ea.

Weight limits for each proposed sign shall be as listed in Attachment A, "Sign Requirements," attached hereto and made part of this agreement.

2. Sign Supports and Hardware. In addition, the Local Jurisdiction hereby orders the Following quantities of sign supports with appropriate hardware, and the State hereby agrees to administer Federal funds to provide the sign supports and hardware at no cost to the Local Jurisdiction.

Posts 2 each

3. Authorization. The Local Jurisdiction shall properly authorize all proposed signs by ordinance, resolution, or other appropriate action and shall provide a copy of such which shall be attached hereto and designated Attachment B.
4. Delivery. The Local Jurisdiction shall take delivery of all proposed signs, sign supports, and hardware as agreed upon with the appropriate Texas Department of Transportation District Office.
5. Installation and Documentation. The Local Jurisdiction shall install all proposed signs in accordance with requirements of Attachment C, "Load Posting Signs," and Attachment D, "Vertical and Lateral Clearances". The Local Jurisdiction shall document the installation by marking the date sticker affixed to the back of each sign.
6. Notification and Inspection. The Local Jurisdiction shall notify the appropriate Texas Department of Transportation District Office in writing within 15 days after all Proposed signs have been properly installed. The Local Jurisdiction shall allow the Federal Highway Administration to perform on-site inspection of the installed signs and shall adjust any signs that are found to be improperly installed.
7. Maintenance. The Local Jurisdiction shall keep the installed signs clean, legible, and open to the view of approaching motorists for at least 150 feet. The Local Jurisdiction shall reinstall signs that have been knocked down by vandalism, traffic accidents, or other causes.
8. State Responsibility. The appropriate Texas Department of Transportation District Office agrees to provide the Local Jurisdiction with reasonable consultation assistance in accomplishing the objectives of this agreement.
9. State Indemnified. The Local Jurisdiction shall save harmless the State from all claims and liabilities due to activities of the Local Jurisdiction, its agents, officials, or employees performed under this agreement and which result from an error, omission, or negligent act of the Local Jurisdiction, its agents, officials, or employees. The Local Jurisdiction shall also save harmless the State from any and all expensed, including attorney fees which might be incurred by the State in litigation or otherwise resisting said claims or liabilities.

10. Disputes. Should disputes arise under this contract, the State's decision shall be final and binding.
11. Civil Rights Compliance. With regard to work performed under this contract, the Local Jurisdiction, in compliance with regulations of the Department of Transportation (49CFR21 and 23CFR710.405), Executive Orders 11246 and 11375 regarding Equal Employment Opportunity, and regulations of the Department of Labor (41 CFR60), shall not discriminate on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin.
12. Inspection of Books and Records. The Federal Highway Administration, the Department of Transportation, the Office of Inspector General, and the Comptroller General of the United States, or any duty authorized representatives thereof, shall have access to any books, documents, papers, and records which are directly pertinent to this contract for the purpose of making audits, examinations, excerpts, and transcriptions.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the State and Local Jurisdiction have executed duplicate counterparts of this Agreement.

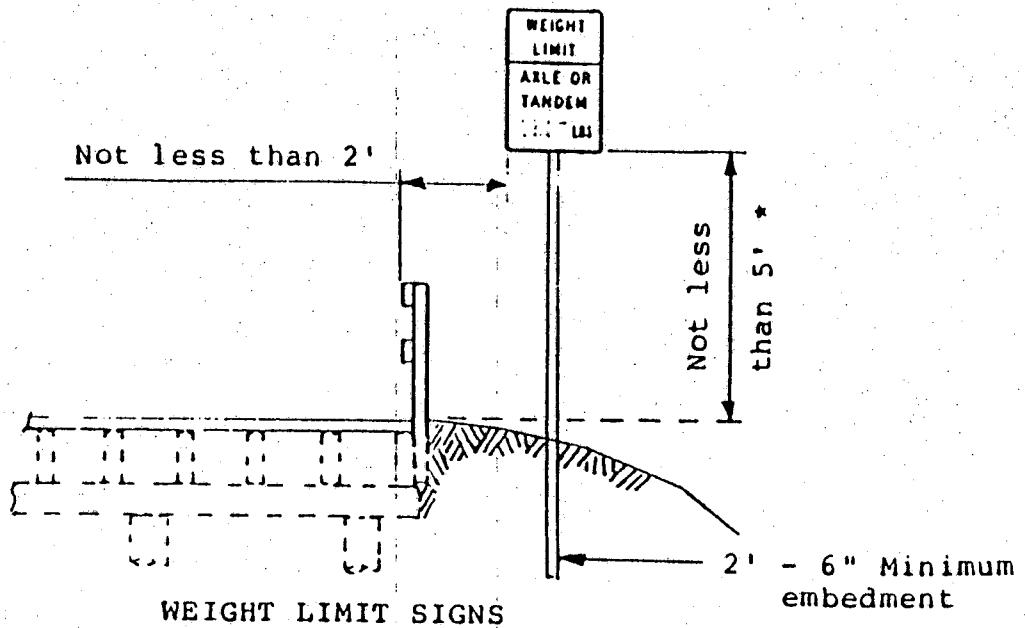
A Weight Limit sign shall be located just ahead of the bridge in each direction of travel. Six feet from the abutment is a good location if the bridge is on an unpaved or low-speed road. This distance should be increased if the bridge is on a high-speed road.



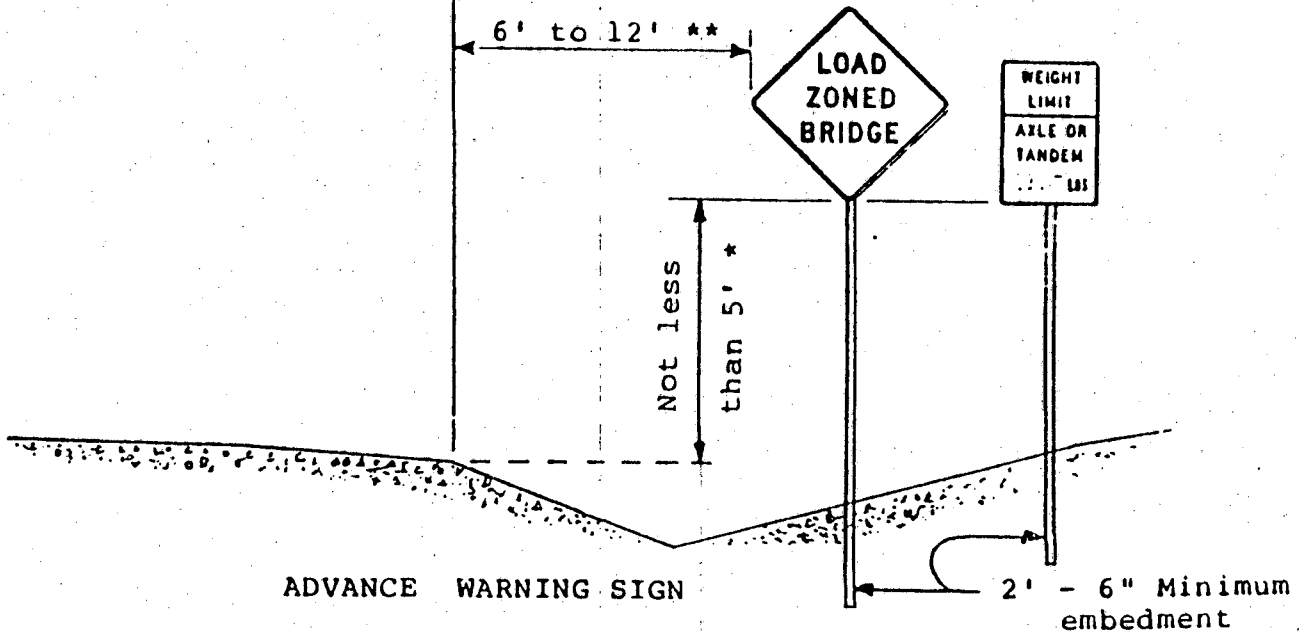

### ADVANCE WARNING SIGN

The Load Zone Bridge sign should be used to warn of a bridge with a posted weight restriction. The sign should be placed so as to allow the driver of an overweight vehicle to detour around the bridge. It is also recommended that a WEIGHT LIMIT sign be placed beside or 100 feet behind each advance warning sign.
