Re: Activity Report on Delinquent Tax Collections Reporting period of January 1, 1998 through April 10, 2000 / Delinquent Tax Contract Renewal

Dear Judge Owens:

In an effort to keep you and Commissioners Court informed as to our activities, we would submit this report which summarizes our work and the results we have achieved in delinquent tax collections on behalf of Tyler County

We are enclosing a renewal contract that will, if approved, continue our delinquent tax collection services for Tyler County. The purposes of this letter are to briefly summarize our collection activities on behalf of the Tyler County and to respectfully submit our application for a contract renewal.

MAILINGS

During this reporting period our law firm has continued an extensive mailing program to ensure that delinquent taxpayers are aware that they owe taxes to Tyler County. We have sent almost 30,000 warning notice letters written in increasing severity of tone to delinquent taxpayers during this reporting period. Every taxpayer on your delinquent roll with a current address has heard from us at least nine (9) times.

LAWSUITS

Where requests for payment and all other negotiations have failed, we have backed up our notice letters with lawsuits. During this reporting period we have filed 166 lawsuits against over 500 defendants and 199 parcels of real property seeking the collection of slightly more than \$320,000 in delinquent taxes, penalties, and interest. At the same time, we have continued to prosecute any case which was already pending prior to this reporting period.

DISMISSALS

Upon our filing a suit, the property owner frequently voluntarily pays the taxes after being served with citation. It is our practice to then dismiss the case, and the litigation comes to an end as to that particular person and property. During this reporting period, we have dismissed, as paid, a total of 25 lawsuits that involved in excess of \$45,000 in taxes, penalties, and interest.

JUDGMENTS / SALES

Courtroom judgments have been taken in 79 lawsuits involving more than \$138,000. These judgments include tax foreclosures on 75 tracts of land and 37 personal judgments against owners of delinquent personal property. If payment of the tax is not forthcoming and judgment has previously been entered, our next collection step is to offer the property for sale. During this reporting period we have prosecuted five (5) tax sales involving 21 tracts of real property. Those sales have resulted in over \$25,000 in direct tax revenue.

TOTAL COLLECTIONS

By the use of all of our collection tools, including notice letters, specialized demand letters, and litigation, we have collected on your behalf just over \$676,000 in delinquent taxes, penalty and interest during this reporting period.

We appreciate the opportunity to represent you and will continue working closely with you and the County Tax Assessor – Collector to provide assistance and advice in all property tax matters, including changes in the law brought about by the property tax code. CONTRACT FOR THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT TAXES

THE STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF TYLER

THIS CONTRACT is made and entered into by and between TYLER COUNTY, acting herein by and through its governing body, hereinafter styled First Party, and the law firm of LINEBARGER HEARD GOGGAN BLAIR GRAHAM PEÑA & SAMPSON, LLP, 1949 South I.H. 35, Austin, Texas, hereinafter styled Second Party.

First Party agrees to employ and does hereby employ Second Party to enforce by suit or otherwise the collection of all delinquent taxes, penalty and interest owing to First Party and all other taxing jurisdictions whose taxes are collected by First Party. Current taxes falling delinquent within the period of this contract shall become subject to its terms when placed in litigation or on the first day of July of the year in which the taxes become delinquent, whichever date is sooner.

Second Party is to call to the attention of the collector or other officials any errors, double assessments or other discrepancies coming under its observation during the progress of the work, and is to intervene on behalf of First Party in all suits for taxes hereafter filed by any taxing unit on property located within its corporate limits.

Second Party shall perform the following special services:

- (a) perform mass mailing of delinquent tax notices a minimum of four (4) times each year to all delinquent taxpayers for whom addresses are available from the county tax office, unless such taxpayer(s) is in bankruptcy.
- (b) address five (5) delinquent accounts styled "unknown owner" each month in an effort to resolve ownership and/or validity of assessment together with reports on resolution each quarter.
- (c) provide a written over-all delinquent tax collection report four (4) times each year.

IV

First Party agrees to pay to Second Party as compensation for the services required hereunder fifteen (15%) percent of the amount collected of all delinquent taxes, penalty and interest for the years covered by this contract, actually collected and paid to the collector of taxes during the term of this contract, as and when collected. All compensation above provided for shall become the property of Second Party at the time payment of the taxes, penalty and interest is made to the collector. The collector shall pay over said funds monthly by check.

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In those cases where collection of taxes are enforced by suit, First Party agrees to furnish to Second Party the name, identity, and location of necessary parties, together with legal descriptions of property on which delinquent taxes are due. Second Party shall, however, advance all charges and expenses on behalf of First Party which are incurred in procuring such information. Any recovery of such expenses by First Party under TEX. TAX CODE ANN. §33.48 shall be paid over to Second Party as and when collected.

This contract is drawn to cover a period of two years beginning July 1, 2000. Thereafter, this contract will continue on a month to month basis until such time as First Party notifies Second Party that it does not wish to continue the agreement. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, this agreement may be terminated by First Party at any time by the giving of thirty (30) days written notice thereof to Second Party. Second Party shall have six months following termination of the contract to reduce to judgment all suits filed prior thereto. In consideration of the terms and compensation herein stated, Second Party hereby accepts said employment and undertakes the performance of said contract as above written.

This contract is executed on behalf of First Party by the presiding officer of its governing body who is authorized to execute this instrument by order heretofore passed and duly recorded in its minutes.
