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### TYLER COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' COURT

### ORDER

WHEREAS, at an election held on the 3rd day of June, 2000, in that part of Tyler County, State of Texas, described as following the existing boundaries of the Tyler County Rural Fire Protection District #2, that is; all of Ivanhoe West of US Highway 69/287; all of Hillister Corp. Limits, then south along a line following the Warren ISD boundary eastward from US Highway 69/287 to the boundary of the Spurger ISD boundary; then north to FM 1013; then west to Pope Mill Road; then north to Spring Hill Road; then west to Seneca Road; then south to the North Hillister Town Line; then west to US Highway 69/287; then north to the North limits of the Ivanhoe Subdivision. There was submitted to the qualified voters the question of whether that territory should be converted into an Emergency Services District under State law; and

WHEREAS, at the election, 125 votes were cast in favor of formation of the district and 70 votes were cast against formation; and

WHEREAS, the conversion to an Emergency Services District received the affirmative vote of the majority of the votes cast at the election as provided by law.

NOW THEREFORE, the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, State of Texas, finds and ORDERS that the tract described in this Order has been duly and legally formed into an Emergency Services District (or a portion thereof) under the name of TYLER COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT #1 under Article III, Section 48e, of the Texas Constitution, as proposed by S.J.R. No. 27, Acts of the 70th Legislature, Regular Session, 1987, and adopted by the voters to an election held November 3, 1987 and has the powers vested by law in the district.
