Leon Hastings addressed his discontentment with the accountability of cost and length of time it has taken to implement 911 in Tyler County. Van Bush presented copies of the State reports that had gone through several audits. Mr. Hastings stated the present system was no more than a "caller ID" system he had on his home phone. There was also a problem with getting a private road number assigned to a road that had five residents. Commissioner Sawyer felt DETCOG had to assign the numbers. Mr. Bush answered they would assign a number only upon authorization from the commissioner's court. Vann also stated the type of system Mr. Hastings was referring to be a graphic MSAG that would be funded through the State in 2002. Commissioner Woodrome summarized that the focus should be on solutions and not on problems of the past:
