James Allison, attorney at law presented a permit for Tyler County Water Supply. The permit would allow water lines under **county roads**, extending service to areas where easements could not be obtained. The area of intention is in Lake Hyatt and Warren High School in **Precinct #4**, with the majority of the properties in **Precinct #1**. A motion was made by **Commissioner Woodrome** and seconded by **Commissioner Sawyer** to approve the permit subject to the approval of the Criminal District Attorney, **Joe Smith**. David Bruno with Texas Department of Transportation presented a Real Estate Acquisition Guide to **Commissioner Marshall**. He indicated the Right-of-Way for the Highway 92 extension would have to be purchased by Tyler County. He indicated some alignment changes due to possible "Indian" sites. The County would also be responsible for having the utilities in the right-of-way moved. Mr. Bruno also presented a schematic of Highway 69. **Commissioners Marshall** and **Woodrome** expressed concern over the amount of constituent's property needed and limited access for residents in the Hillister area.
