Orders, that the Justice Court Technology Fund is created and shall take effect on September 1, 2001, to continue for the duration provided by law; and


Orders, that each justice court in Tyler County shall assess a technology fee of \$4.00 as cost of court on each conviction, as defined by Art. 102.0173, Code of Criminal Procedure, for a fine-only misdemeanor committed on or after September 1, 2001; and further

Orders that the justice courts of Tyler County shall deposit all such fees collected with the county treasurer for deposit in the account of Justice Court Technology Fund.

The Commissioners Court of Tyler County will administer the fund hereby created to be used in accordance with Art. 102.0173, Code of Criminal Procedure. This Order will expire, in accordance with Art. 102.0173, Code of Criminal Procedure, On September 1, 2005.

Orders that the justice courts of Tyler County shall deposit all such fees collected with the county treasurer for deposit in the account of the Justice Court Technology Fund.
