A motion was made by **Commissioner Marshall** and seconded by **Commissioner Walston** to approve the minutes of August 12, 2002. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Hughes** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to approve paying the **bills** as submitted by the **County Auditor**. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** to accept private roads numbered 8636, 8638 and 8639 as county roads in Precinct #4. **Commissioner Hughes** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED DEDICATIONS.

Retired Judge, Allen Sturrock thanked the court for their service to the **County Hospital** and the Burke Center. He added a warm thanks to State Representative Jim McReynolds for his assistance in obtaining a grant from Temple for the hospital. **Commissioner Marshall** motioned to reappoint Judge Allen Sturrock to the Board of Trustees of the Burke Center for a two year term. **Commissioner Walston** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED LETTER

George Walker and Jeff McCrae presented a report of delinquent taxes. Filed suits had brought in \$64,455.35. Mr. Walker praised Sheriff Hennigan for the fast service of citations and notices to expedite the tax suits. He also commended Lynnette Cruse for the assistance of the tax office. A public sale of trust properties has been set for September.

Clint Robinson presented a proposal for a metal detector to be installed outside the district courtroom. He recommended a model that had been used at the Olympics. Joe Smith and Gary Hennigan also spoke in favor of installing a metal detector. Mr. Smith requested the court also consider a holding cell for TDC prisoners and inmates awaiting appearance in the courtroom. After questioning warranties and repairs **Commissioner Marshall** motioned to approve up to \$2500 from Courthouse Security Funds for the purchase of a metal detector. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Walston**. SEE ATTACHED

Sheriff Hennigan announced the lowest bid received for a **pick up truck** did not meet the specifications; and, to do so would result in an additional amount. **Commissioner Marshall** motioned to accept the bid from Woodville Ford as recommended by Sheriff Hennigan for a truck in the amount of \$22,186.04. The motion was seconded by **Commissioner Walston**. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** and seconded by **Commissioner Hughes** to adopt a resolution recognizing September 2002 as Leukemia and Lymphoma Awareness Month. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED RESOLUTION


Commissioner Walston introduced Jeff Hunter and Stanley Potts with SANTEK Environmental services. They indicated operation of the Polk County Landfill since December 2001 along with 11 other landfills since 1984. Judge Owens announced this item has been placed for bids to be presented on September 9th. *This was not an agenda item- only introductions were received.*




Commissioner Hughes motioned the meeting adjourned.



Dear Judge Owens:

In an effort to keep you and the members of the Commissioners Court informed as to our activities, we would submit this report that summarizes our collection work on behalf of Tyler County.

MAILINGS

During this reporting period our law firm has continued a system of mailings that will insure that delinquent taxpayers are aware that they owe taxes to Tyler County. It has been our experience that providing taxpayers frequent reminders of their obligation tends to increase the likelihood that the taxpayer will take steps to resolve the delinquency. Mailings for the county were conducted during the following periods and involving the following number of mailings:

March 2001	1,988
July 2001	2,628
September 2001	3,260
November 2001	1,835
February 2002	2,086
July 2002	3,684

LITIGATION

Where request for payment and all other negotiations have failed, we have backed up our notice letters with lawsuits. During this reporting period we have filed over 124 real property, mineral property and personal property lawsuits to collect delinquent property taxes. Those suit filings represent over \$184,054.66 in delinquent property taxes due Tyler County. Not only have we filed new lawsuits against these properties, we have also continued to prosecute the cases that were pending prior to this reporting period. A listing of those collection lawsuits that have been filed is attached.

Frequently, after filing our lawsuits, the property owner voluntarily pays the taxes after being served with citation. It is our practice to then dismiss the case and the litigation comes to an end as to that particular person and property. During this reporting period, we have dismissed a total of **51 lawsuits** that involve in excess of **\$64,455.35** in taxes, penalty and interest. A summary of these dismissals is attached.


During this reporting period, courtroom judgments have been taken in over **101 lawsuits** involving over **\$171,130.71**. These judgments, attached, include tax foreclosure on 114 tracts of real property and 15 personal judgments against owners of delinquent personal property.

TAX SALES

A sale of real property occurs when a judgment has been entered and the property owner fails to take any action to satisfy the outstanding debt. Our judgments foreclose the ad valorem tax lien on the property and contain language that authorize the Sheriff to execute on the property and judgment. During this reporting period there have been **120 defendants** involved in real property tax sales at which we offered for purchase some **44 pieces of real property** located within Tyler County. The results of those sales are attached.

As always we appreciate the opportunity to report to you and will continue to keep you, the tax office and the Commissioners Court informed as to our activities as well as to developments in ad valorem tax law as it may impact Tyler County.

WHEREAS, Tyler County Commissioners' Court is similarly committed to the eradication of these diseases and supports the treatment of its citizens that suffer from them; and


WHEREAS, Tyler County Commissioners' Court encourages private efforts to enhance research funding and education programs that address these diseases.


