
BE IT ORDERED by the Commissioner's of Tyler County that;

We, the Commissioner's Court of Tyler County, do hereby levy or adopt the tax rate on \$100 valuation for this County for the tax year 2002 as follows:







ORDER TO ADOPT ARCHIVAL FIVE YEAR PLAN

Whereas, Local Government Code, Section 118.011(e), enabled the Commissioners' Court to adopt a Records Archive Fee, for the preservation and restoration services performed by the County Clerk in connection with maintaining a County Clerk's records archive;

Whereas, Commissioners' Court approved a Records Archive Fee of \$5 on August 15, 2003, which the County Clerk's office will collect at the time of filing or recording of any public record;

Whereas, the fee shall be deposited in a separate line item of the Records Management Account of the County Clerk of Tyler County;

Whereas, after Commissioners' Court approval on August 15, 2003, presentation of the Archival Five Year Plan, public hearing and the plan being accepted as presented;


Now therefore, be it ordered by the Commissioners' Court of Tyler County, pursuant to the Local Government Code, Section 118.011(e), hereby adopts the Archival Five Year Plan to be implemented by the County Clerk at the time of filing or recording of any public document. Further, the \$5.00 fee may be expended only for preservation and restoration of the County Clerk's records archive. The funds may not be used to purchase, lease, or develop computer software to geographically index public records for current recordings.





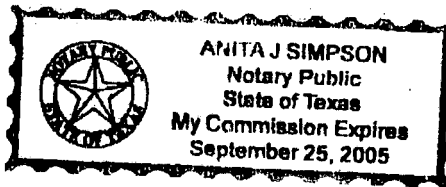
