A motion was a made by Commissioner Woodrome and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to approve the minutes of October 14, 2003. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to approves the paying the bills as submitted by the County Auditor. Commissioner Walston seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by Commissioner Walston and seconded by Commissioner Woodrome to approve the line-item transfer, as submitted by the County Auditor, for the adjustment of the community service budget. All voted yes and none no. ATTACHED

John Paul Feely reported reimbursement of \$18,745 to fire departments, sheriff's department and Constable, Pct.#1 for the Moss Hill hazard. A motion was made by Commissioner Walston to approve the Mutual Aid Agreement between Tyler County and DETCOG. Commissioner Woodrome seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT.

A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Woodrome to approve the contract to collect taxes for Warren ISD. All voted yes and none no.

Donece Gregory reported she had spoken with representatives from the companies now working in her department concerning the prioritized use, of a reader/printer, by Anadarko Oil. Responses were favorable such as "it will actually help". Commissioner Woodrome motioned to approve the letter of Agreement between Tyler County and John Robertson for a microfilm reader printer for the County Clerk's Department in exchange for copies equal to the cost of equipment. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. Judge Owens added there was no guarantee the equipment would not be used by the public. SEE ATTACHED AGREEMENT.

Kinney Simpson presented a **Community Service Agreement** between the county and the Adult **Probation Department**. He reported his department had lost over \$60,000 in funding of which \$44,000 was in the community service division. Mr. Simpson added that Judge Owens had gotten a bill sponsored for the District Judges and other key personnel to have liability coverage. Commissioner Walston commended Mr. Simpson of the fine job they do for the county; **Commissioner Woodrome** echoed the sentiments adding the savings of tax dollars to the citizens then motioned to approve the agreement

as presented. Commissioner Marshall seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED.

Commissioner Woodrome motioned to approve the election judge of Voting Precinct #6 to count the early votes along with the votes cast on election day, November 4th. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walston. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woodrome and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to authorize three election clerks for Precinct #6 for the Village Mills Fire Preventions District Election. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woodrome and seconded by Commissioner Marshall to table consideration of an additional phone line for the DPS office, until a representative could meet with the court. All voted yes and none no.

John Craig reported 2.6 million dollars in services had been award to veterans in Tyler County. Commissioner Woodrome motioned to approve an additional phone line, to be used for a fax line, for the Veteran's Service office at the Burke center. Commissioner Walston seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. Mr. Craig reported the VFW volunteers will be taking the appointments for the van service.

Clint Sturrock presented the report of racial profile arrests made by the Sheriff's Department for the period January 1, 2002 to March 31, 2003. Since cameras had been placed in patrol cars, a subsequent report will not be required. A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Woodrome to accept the report. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Marshall motioned to accept the bid from George Baine for a maintainer for Precinct #2 in the amount of \$118,193.00. After a tradein, the remainder will be paid by time warrants for five years with the first warrant due January 2005. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Woodrome. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED BID.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woodrome to appoint Cleata Wills and Tracy Bump to the Child Welfare Board, as requested by Terry Allen. Commissioner Walston seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Commissioner Woodrome reported the proposed subdivision had a street that had been brought up to county specifications and motioned to accept .150 mile of road as a county road to be known as CR1327; and, the plat of Black Creek Subdivision for recording purposes. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walston. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED PLAT.

Representatives of Gold Star EMS and Priority One EMS requested a contract with the county for ambulance services. Two trucks would be covering the county seven days a week. Commissioners Marshall and Woodrome commented the court should not be making a choice between two ambulance services. Judges Owens added Tyler County Hospital officials were not in favor of the contract; therefore the court would not move forward until this matter could be worked out with the hospital. No action was taken.

A motion was made by Commissioner Woodrome for the meeting to adjourn.
