A motion was made by Commissioner Hughes and seconded by Commissioner Walston to approve the minutes of April 16<sup>th</sup> and June 14, 2004 with correction of Emergency Service District #1 instead of #4 in the June 14<sup>th</sup> minutes. All voted yes and none no.

Joyce Moore made the court aware that repair bills for the jail will be over budget. Commissioner Marshall inquired as to paying the jail repairs from tax money collected for the jail. Mrs. Moore responded this would be acceptable if approved by the commissioners. A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Walston to approve paying the bills as submitted by the County Auditor; and, to pay the repairs to the Justice Center from the Jail INS. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

A motion was made by **Commissioner Walston** to approve an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Woodville for waste disposal for emergency purposes. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Terry Allen presented a request for a typewriter for the Juvenile Probation Department secretary, Kathy Harris. Comparing the price of the typewriter purchased recently for the commissioners' secretary, **Commissioner Marshall** motioned to approve up to \$250 for the purchase of a typewriter. **Commissioner Woodrome** seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no.

Randy Blanks presented a report of nine sites for grant funded sewer installation.

Commissioner Marshall motioned approve the nine sites and to set the bid opening date for on-site sewer installations for July 8<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m., as recommended by Randy Blanks. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Walston. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Justice of Peace Pct.#1, Brian Weatherford presented a request to approve a contract with OMNI BASE as a database for warrants. Mr. Weatherford reported this replacement of the warrant data base would be at no cost to the county; the funding comes from assessment of court cost. #### 1. PARTIES:

This Interlocal Cooperation Contract ("Contract") is made and entered into between the County of Tyler ("County"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and the City of Woodville ("City"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas.

#### 2. <u>OVERVIEW</u>:

The purpose of this Contract is for the County to contract with the City to perform governmental functions and services in the area of waste disposal in accordance with Texas Government Code Chapter 791. The performance of these governmental functions and services in the area of waste disposal shall be performed by the City at no cost to the County. The consideration for this Contract is the mutual agreement between the County and City for the exchange of and use of certain waste disposal equipment between these two (2) political subdivisions during emergency situations as mutually determined by the respective designated agent of these political subdivisions.

### 3. <u>GOVERNING LAW:</u>

This Contract is entered into pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 791 and is subject to the laws and jurisdiction of the State of Texas and shall be construed and interpreted accordingly.

#### 4. <u>VENUE</u>:

The parties agree that this Contract is deemed performable in Tyler County, Texas, and that venue for any suit arising from the interpretation or enforcement of this Contract shall lie in Tyler County, Texas.

#### 5. <u>COMPLIANCE WITH LAW:</u>

The County and City both understand and agree that it will comply with all local, state and federal laws in the performance of this Contract.

#### 6. LITIGATION AND INDEMNITY:

In the event that the County is aware of litigation in which this Contract is subject to constitutional, statutory, or common-law challenge, or is struck down by judicial decision, the County shall make a good faith effort to notify the City immediately.

Each party may participate in the defense of a claim or suit affecting this Contract, but no

costs or expenses shall be incurred for any party by the other party without the other parties written consent.

To the extent authorized by law, the County agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City against any claims, suits, actions, damages and costs of every nature or description arising out of or resulting from the performance of this Contract by the City on behalf of the County, and the County further agrees to satisfy any final judgment awarded against the County or the City arising from the performance of this Contract by the City on behalf of the County, provided said claim, suit, action, damage, judgment or related cost is not attributed by the judgment of a court of competent jurisdiction to the sole negligence of the City.

It is the agreement of the parties that any litigation involving the parties to this Contract may not be compromised or settled without the express consent of the County, unless such litigation does not name the County as a party.

#### 7. CONTRACT MODIFICATION:

No modifications, amendments or supplements to, or waivers of, any provision of this Contract shall be valid unless made in writing and executed in the same manner as this Contract.

### 8. SEVERABILITY:

If any provision of this Contract is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable under present or future laws effective during the term hereof, such provision shall be fully severable. This Contract shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision had never comprised a part hereof, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be affected by the illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision or by its severance therefrom.

The parties herein agree for the submission of disputes arising under the Contract to the alternative dispute resolution procedures authorized by Texas Government Code Chapter 2009.

# **Interlocal Cooperation Contract**

STATE OF TEXAS

COUNTY OF Tyler

#### I. Parties

This Interlocal Cooperation Contract ("Contract") is made and entered into between the Texas Department of Public Safety ("TDPS"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, and the \_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, a local political subdivision of the State of Texas.

#### II. Overview

The purpose of this Contract is to implement the provisions of Texas Transportation Code Chapter 706. A local political subdivision may contract with the TDPS to provide information necessary to deny renewal of the driver license of a person who fails to appear for a complaint or citation or fails to pay or satisfy a judgement ordering payment of a fine or cost in the manner ordered by the court in a manner involving any offense within the jurisdiction of the justice or municipal court.

The TDPS has authority to contract with a private vendor ("Vendor") pursuant to Texas Transportation Code §706.008. The Vendor will provide the necessary goods and services to establish an automated system ("FTA System") whereby information regarding violators subject to the provisions of Texas Transportation Code Chapter 706 may be accurately stored and accessed by the TDPS. Utilizing the FTA System as a source of information, the TDPS may deny renewal of a driver license to a person who is the subject of an FTA System entry.

Each local political subdivision contracting with the TDPS will pay monies to the Vendor based on a fee certain established by this Contract. The TDPS will make no direct or indirect payments to the Vendor. The Vendor will ensure that accurate information is available to the TDPS, political subdivisions and persons seeking to clear their licenses at all reasonable times.

#### III. Definitions

"Complaint" means notice of an offense as defined in Article 27.14(d) or Article 45.019, Code of Criminal Procedure.

"Department" or "TDPS" means the Texas Department of Public Safety.

"Failure to Appear Program" or "FTA Program" refers to the implementation efforts of all parties, including those system components provided by the TDPS, local political subdivisions and the Vendor, including the FTA System.

"Failure to Appear System" or "FTA System" refers to the goods and services, including all hardware, software, consulting services, telephone and related support services, supplied by the Vendor.

"FTA Software" refers to computer software developed or maintained now or in the future by the Vendor to support the FTA System.

"Originating Court" refers to the court in which an applicable violation has been filed for which a person has failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgement and which has submitted an appropriate FTA report.

"State" refers to the State of Texas.

"Local political subdivision" refers to a city or county of the State of Texas.

Unless otherwise defined, terms used herein shall have the meaning assigned by Texas Transportation Code Chapter 706 or other relevant statute. Terms not defined in this Contract or by other relevant statutes shall be given their ordinary meanings.

### IV. Governing Law

This Contract is entered into pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 791 and is subject to the laws and jurisdiction of the State of Texas and shall be construed and interpreted accordingly.

#### V. Venue

The parties agree that this contract is deemed performable in Travis County, Texas, and that venue for any suit arising from the interpretation or enforcement of this Contract shall lie in Travis County, Texas.

### VI. Application and Scope of Contract

This Contract applies to each FTA report submitted to and accepted by the TDPS or the Vendor by the local political subdivision pursuant to the authority of Texas Transportation Code Chapter 706.

### VII. Required Warning on Citation for Traffic Law Violations

A peace officer authorized to issue citations within the jurisdiction of the local political subdivision shall issue a written warning to each person to whom the officer issues a citation for a traffic law violation. This warning shall be provided in addition to any other warnings required by law. The warning must state in substance that if the person fails to appear in court for the prosecution of the offense or if the person fails to pay or satisfy a judgement ordering the payment of a fine and cost in the manner ordered by the court, the person may be denied renewal of the person's driver license. The written warning may be printed on the citation or on a separate instrument.

# VIII. FTA Report

If the person fails to appear or fails to pay or satisfy a judgement as required by law, the local political subdivision may submit an FTA report containing the following information:

(1) the jurisdiction in which the alleged offense occurred;

(2) the name of the local political subdivision submitting the report;

(3) the name, date of birth and Texas driver license number of the person who failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgement;

(4) the date of the alleged violation;

(5) a brief description of the alleged violation;

(6) a statement that the person failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a

judgement as required by law;

- (7) the date that the person failed to appear or failed to pay or satisfy a judgement; and
- (8) any other information required by the TDPS.

There is no requirement that a criminal warrant be issued in response to the person's failure to appear. The local political subdivision must make reasonable efforts to ensure that all FTA Reports are accurate, complete and non-duplicative.

# IX. Clearance Reports

The originating court that files the FTA Report has a continuing obligation to review the report and promptly submit appropriate additional information or reports to the Vendor or the TDPS. The clearance report shall identify the person, state whether or not a fee was required, advise the TDPS to lift the denial of renewal and state the grounds for the action. All clearance reports must be submitted within five business days of the time and date that the originating court receives appropriate payment or other information that satisfies the citizen's obligation to that court.

To the extent that a local political subdivision utilizes the FTA Program by submitting an FTA Report, there is a corresponding obligation to collect the statutorily required \$30.00 administrative fee. If the person is acquitted of the underlying offense for which the original FTA Report was filed, the originating court shall not require payment of the administrative fee. The local political subdivision shall submit a clearance report within five business days advising the TDPS to lift the denial of renewal and identifying the grounds for the action.

The local political subdivision must promptly file a clearance report upon payment of the administrative fee and:

- (1) the perfection of an appeal of the case for which the warrant of arrest was issued or judgement arose;
- (2) the dismissal of the charge for which the warrant of arrest was issued or judgement arose;
- (3) the posting of a bond or the giving of other security to reinstate the charge for which the warrant was issued;
- (4) the payment or discharge of the fine and cost owed on an outstanding judgement of the court; or
- (5) other suitable arrangement to pay the fine and cost within the court's discretion.

The TDPS will not continue to deny renewal of the person's driver license after receiving notice from the local political subdivision that the FTA report was submitted in error or has been destroyed in accordance with local political subdivision's record retention policy.

# X. Compliance with Law

The local political subdivision understands and agrees that it will comply with all local, state and federal laws in the performance of this Contract, including administrative rules adopted by the TDPS.

# XI. Accounting Procedures

An officer collecting fees pursuant to Texas Transportation Code §706.006 shall keep separate records of the funds and shall deposit the funds in the appropriate municipal or county treasury. The custodian of the municipal or county treasury may deposit such fees in an interest-bearing account and retain the interest earned thereon for the local political subdivision. The custodian shall keep accurate and complete records of funds received

and disbursed in accordance with this Contract and the governing statutes.

The custodian shall remit \$20.00 of each fee collected pursuant to Texas Transportation Code §706.006 to the Comptroller on or before the last day of each calendar quarter and retain \$10.00 of each fee for payment to the Vendor and credit to the general fund of the municipal or county treasury.

# XII. Payments to Vendor

The TDPS has contracted with OmniBase Services of Texas, LLP. ("Vendor"), a partnership organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Texas, with its principal place of business in Austin, Texas, to assist with the implementation of the FTA Program.

The local political subdivision must pay the Vendor a fee of \$6.00 per person for each violation which has been reported to the Vendor and for which the local political subdivision has subsequently collected the statutorily required \$30.00 administrative fee. In the event that the person has been acquitted of the underlying charge, no payment will be made to the Vendor or required of the local political subdivision.

The parties agree that payment shall be made by the local political subdivision to the Vendor no later than the last day of the month following the close of the calendar quarter in which the payment was received by the local political subdivision.

# XIII. Litigation and Indemnity

In the event that the local political subdivision is aware of litigation in which this Contract or Texas Transportation Code Chapter 706 is subject to constitutional, statutory, or commonlaw challenge, or is struck down by judicial decision, the local political subdivision shall make a good faith effort to notify the TDPS immediately.

Each party may participate in the defense of a claim or suit affecting the FTA Program, but no costs or expenses shall be incurred for any party by the other party without the other parties written consent.

To the extent authorized by law, the local political subdivision agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the TDPS against any claims, suits, actions, damages and costs of every nature or description arising out of or resulting from the performance of this Contract, and the local political subdivision further agrees to satisfy any final judgement awarded against the local political subdivision or the TDPS arising from the performance of this Contract, provided said claim, suit, action, damage, judgement or related cost is not attributed by the judgement of a court of competent jurisdiction to the sole negligence of the TDPS.

It is the agreement of the parties that any litigation involving the parties to this Contract may not be compromised or settled without the express consent of the TDPS, unless such litigation does not name the TDPS as a party.

This section is subject to the statutory rights and duties of the Attorney General for the State of Texas.

#### XIV. Contract Modification

No modifications, amendments or supplements to, or waivers of, any provision of this Contract shall be valid unless made in writing and executed in the same manner as this Contract.

# XV. Severability

If any provision of this Contract is held to be illegal, invalid or unenforceable under present or future laws effective during the term hereof, such provision shall be fully severable. This Contract shall be construed and enforced as if such illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision had never comprised a part hereof, and the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect and shall not be affected by the illegal, invalid or unenforceable provision or by its severance therefrom.

# XVI. Multiple Counterparts

This agreement may be executed in a number of identical counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original for all purposes and all of which constitutes, collectively, one agreement. But, in making proof of this agreement, it shall not be necessary to produce or account for more than one such counterpart.

#### XVII. Effective Date of Contract

This contract shall be in effect from and after the date that the final signature is set forth below. This contract shall automatically renew on a yearly basis. However, either party may terminate this agreement upon thirty dates written notice to the other party. Notice may be given at the following addresses:

# **DISTRICT REPORT FOR FISCAL 2003**

MAY 1 0 2004

- A. The third year of the District's operations has been reasonably normal. There have been several high points but they were spread out through the year and didn't strain our resources, nor personnel greatly. This report will cover our activities from October 1, 2002 thru September 30, 2003.
- B. Improvements during this fiscal year have continued along the lines as stated in our original plan at the creation of the District. Recruitment and training are showing gains with 8 basic certified firefighters, several firefighters achieving "operations" levels in Hazardous Materials training, the Assistant Chief completing the third year of a five year Officer Development course at the Annual A & M Municipal fire school, and our Fire Marshal completing the 4 week Fire Investigator course and passing the Texas Commission on Fire Protection test to certify with them as an investigator. New recruits are being introduced to the fire service with training at the basic level, and all personnel are taking advantage of outside schools when possible to advance their skills in specialized subjects. Late in the year we have started a "Driver Operator" class for all hands that covers operation and driving skills of pumper and tanker trucks. We expect to finish this in the next year and qualify most of the personnel as "driver/Operator" under the State Firemen and Fire Marshals' training program.
- C. During the summer we installed 3 dry hydrants on Lakes Charmane and Galahad to improve water supplies at points that would be closer to the fire scene as opposed to returning to the station for reloads. Reductions in travel time translate to reduced lost time at the fire and improve the suppression activities. Additional dry hydrants have been obtained and will be installed during the next summer season.
- D. In keeping with our commitment to the County Haz-Mat Response Team, we have obtained a donation from the Moon Run VFD of Moon Run, Pa of a 1985 Ford/Horton box body ambulance that they were using as a Squad truck. This allows us a vehicle to concentrate all of our equipment and supplies on one vehicle for ease of response. We also have gotten 4 Level A fully enclosed suits suitable for training use by HM personnel. With current equipment and trained personnel we are able to respond to small to medium size incidents up to a level B standard. Other equipment improvements included purchase of additional portable radios and replacement of 20 year old pagers with new models.
- E. Outstanding events during this year Started with the shuttle disaster and recovery operations. Supplying both search team personnel and our Rehab unit for a period of 10 days, we had an average of 7 people and 2 vehicles every day. Rehab was charged with providing food services to a search group (5 teams) and general support as directed. Later in May of the year, we assisted at the Moss Hill Pipeline fire with tanker and Rehab unit support. Our Rehab supplied all food and drinks during the first day of this incident, assisted with drinks by several FD auxiliaries. The remainder of the year was taken up with normal operations, training, and maintenance and repairs

- F. Of course, the greatest event in the year came in September when we were awarded a FEMA Fire Act Grant in the amount of \$ 185,000.00 for the purchase of a 2500 gallon/1250 gpm Pumper Tanker. This grant is a 90/10 cost sharing grant that obligates us to provide 10 % or \$ 18,500 of the total grant. We will also have to provide approx, \$ 6,000.00 for equipment not included in the grant total. We do not anticipate any problem in this as we have been trying for the grant the past 3 years and have some funds on hand and will provide the rest over the period of the grant which extends until 1 September 2004.
- G. The District continues to meet professional standards in our training and operations. Additional core subject training, new classes dealing with Terrorism, and WMD have and will put a strain on our time availability, however we are meeting the challenge and will continue to do so in the future. Our commitment to provide the best protection and service to our community and our county that is possible continues to lead us and dictate our direction.

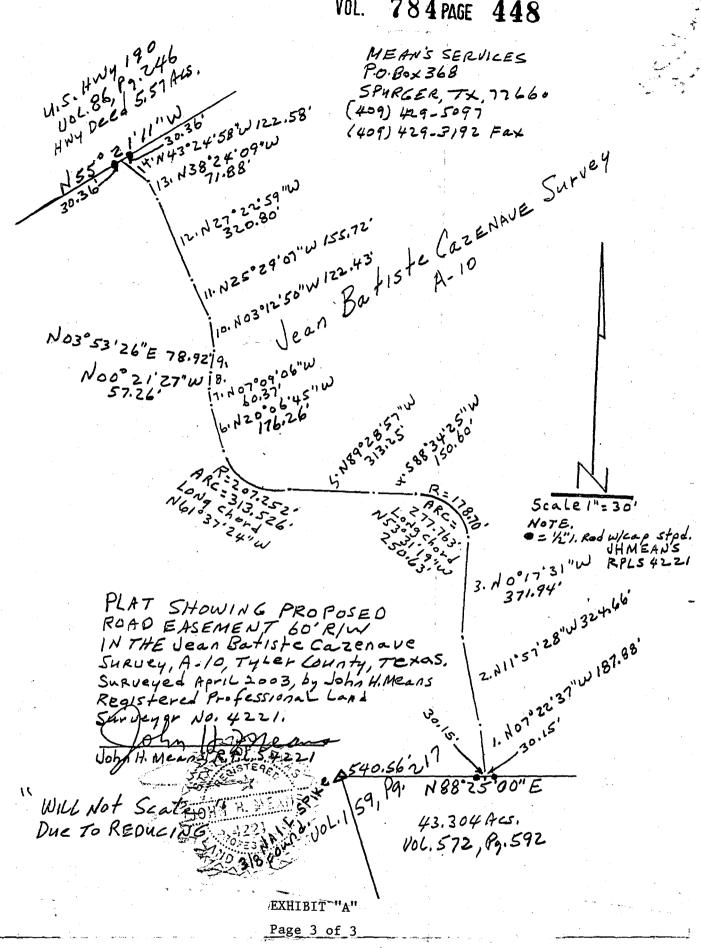
