The County Clerk reported that due to the limited amount of office space, she had received several request from oil and gas landmen for her office to be open on Saturdays. She stated that her employees were willing to work on Saturdays, but that compensatory time would not be a good option due to election time being a busy time needing a full staff. Joe Smith advised that the county could pay the overtime, but law did not allow the oil and gas companies to be billed for reimbursement. Commissioner Marshall suggested a donation as made by timber companies to the county. Mr. Smith felt that donations would be acceptable. Mrs. Gregory explained that her employees could work on cleaning out records from the attic and basement on Saturdays, but the salary line item in Records Management was limited. A motion was made by Commissioner Marshall and seconded by Commissioner Hughes to approve overtime pay to the employees of the County Clerk for Saturdays from 8:00a.m till 2:00p.m. for the next four Saturdays on a trial basis to see if it will be feasible and beneficial to the public to be paid from Records Management. All voted yes and none no.

A motion was made by **Commissioner Woodrome** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to extend a **county road** 1096 by 1 tenth of a mile from residence of Pat and Gladys Riley. All voted and none no.

Commissioner Walston motioned the meeting adjourned.
