WHEREAS, the County Judge of Tyler County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to provide for the safety and well being of the citizens of Tyler County, and;

WHEREAS, in consideration of the warnings and bulletins from the National Hurricane Center, the County Judge is calling for the mandatory evacuation of Tyler County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT DECLARED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF TYLER COUNTY:


That a state of disaster is declared for Tyler County;

That the County Emergency Management Plan be implemented;


That the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than fourteen days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Tyler County Commissioners' Court, and;

That this Declaration of mandatory evacuation shall take effect immediately.
