Judge Owens expressed the course the county had been in the budget process. The  
county is not allowed to adopt a deficit budget. **Commissioner Hughes** motioned to  
adopt the budget for 2006 for a total of \$7,011,755.00. **Commissioner Walston**  
seconded the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED

Being that a tax rate has to be set to meet the **2006 budget**, a motion was made by  
**Commissioner Nash** and seconded by **Commissioner Marshall** to adopt a total **tax rate**  
of .5887. All voted none no. SEE ATTACHED ORDER

The hospital rate requested by the Tyler County Hospital Board of Managers is an  
48.61% over the effective tax rate. A motion was made **Commissioner Hughes** to adopt  
a tax rate of **.1285** for the **Tyler County Hospital**. **Commissioner Marshall** seconded  
the motion. All voted yes and none no. SEE ATTACHED ORDER.


A motion was made by Commissioner Walston that the meeting adjourn.

## ORDER SETTING TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS TAX RATE FOR 2005

Whereas, it is necessary for the Tyler County Commissioners Court to increase the tax levy by 11.22% for 2005 in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Tyler County residents: therefore,

### BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be assessed and collected for 2005 an ad valorem tax of \$.5887 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2005 tax rolls of the county.

This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:


General Fund Maintenance and Operating Expense Tax Rate	\$ .4022
Debt Service Tax Rate	\$ .0000
Road & Bridge Maintenance and Operating Expense Tax Rate	\$ .1865
 2005 Total Ad Valorem Tax Rate	 \$ .5887


2. For comparison purposes, a \$100,000 home (not allowing for exemptions), paid \$588.70 to Tyler County in 2004. In 2005 the same house, at the same value, would pay \$588.70 to Tyler County.
3. That the Tyler County Tax Assessor/Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2005 tax statements and transmit the same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before November 21, 2005, or as soon thereafter as possible.

**ORDER SETTING TYLER COUNTY HOSPITAL TAX RATE FOR 2005**

Whereas, it is necessary for the Tyler County Commissioners Court to increase the tax levy by 48.61% for 2005 in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the Tyler County Hospital, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the Tyler County Hospital: therefore,

**BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:**

1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be assessed and collected for 2005 an ad valorem tax of \$.1285 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2005 tax rolls of the county.

This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following component:



2. For comparison purposes, a \$100,000 home (not allowing for exemptions), paid \$90.30 to Tyler County in 2004. In 2005 the same house, at the same value, would pay \$128.50 to Tyler County, for the benefit of said hospital.
3. That the Tyler County Tax Assessor/Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2005 tax statements and transmit the same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before November 21, 2005, or as soon thereafter as possible.






