DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER, TYLER COUNTY

WHEREAS, the County of Tyler on the 16th day of October, 2006, has suffered widespread damage, and the imminent threat of further damage resulting from flood waters from from severe thunderstorms, and

WHEREAS. The County Judge Pro Tem of the County of Tyler has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE PRO TEM OF TYLER COUNTY:

> That a local state of disaster is hereby proclaimed for Tyler County pursuant to § 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.

- 1. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued for renewed by the Commissioners Court of Tyler County.
- 2. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this Declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk of Tyler County.
- Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this Declaration of the local 3. state of disaster activates the Tyler County Emergency Management Plan.
